I. INTRODUCTION

The College is controlled by the Director of Medical Education & Training, Orissa under the Administration of Health and Family Welfare Deptt. Govt. Of Orissa & academically affiliated to Berhampur University, Bhanja-Bihar, Berhampur-760007. The Indian Nursing Council, New-Delhi has permitted vide INC certificate no.18-24/3201 dated 10.7.06 to conduct the programme.

The College of Nursing, Berhampur started functioning from the year 1983 under U.K.Aid Project (ADP Phase-I) with the sole objective to provide comprehensive nursing educational programme based on sound, scientific health care information. The College have availed all the better opportunities from ADP (U.K.Aid Project) Phase I and II for educational feedback. It has produced a number nurses qualified in the field of Diploma in Public Health Nursing, Basic B.Sc Nursing and P.C.B.Sc Nursing who are working under Govt. of Orissa, Govt. of India, Railway, and other public as well as private sectors.

The College not only provides regular courses but also conducting different short term courses for updating the knowledge and skills of committed Nurses sponsored by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India as well as Govt. of Orissa from time to time.

II. PHILOSOPHY

6. Demonstrate the ability to plan and implement change in nursing practice and in the health care delivery system.
7. Establish collaborative relationship with members of other disciplines
8. Demonstrate interest in continued learning for personal and professional advancement.

V. SELECTION COMMITTEE

Selection of Candidates for the M.Sc Nursing course at College of Nursing, Berhampur affiliated to Berhampur University shall be conducted by the Selection Committee until otherwise directed by the Government.

VI. Eligibility for admission/Registration

1. The Candidate should be a Registered Nurse and Registered Midwife or equivalent with Orissa Nurses & Midwife council as on 30th June'2010.
2. The minimum education requirements shall be the passing of Basic B. Sc nursing/Post-Basic B. Sc nursing with minimum 55% aggregate marks.
3. 5% relaxation of marks for S.C/S.T candidates
4. The candidate should have undergone in B.Sc Nursing/Post Basic B.Sc Nursing in an institution which is recognised by the Indian Nursing council
5. Minimum one year of work experience after Basic B.Sc Nursing as on 30th June'2010

- 6 Minimum one-year work experience prior or after Post-Basic B.Sc Nursing as on 30th June'2010
7. Candidate shall be medically fit to undergo M.Sc Nursing Course.
8. Should not be more than 50 years of age as on 30th June 2010
9. Should be permanent resident of Orissa.
- 10 .Must exercise Bond and agreement to serve the state Govt. for at least five years at the time of admission.

VII. OVERVIEW

1. DURATION OF COURSE

The duration of Master of Science in nursing programme shall be of two academic years. Which shall commence from 2nd week of July every year that should be completed within 30 days without fine and by 31st August on payment of late fee as prescribed by the University from time to time.

Distribution of seats in the areas of specialisation:

➔	Medical Surgical Nursing	:	Four seats
➔	Obstetrics & Gynaecological Nursing:		Two seats
➔	Community Health Nursing	:	Two seats
➔	Paediatric Nursing	:	Two seats

2. LEAVE:

No leave of any kind shall be allowed except the vacation prescribed in the regulation of the Berhampur University.

3. ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENT:

A candidate shall have minimum of 80% attendance in a year (irrespective of the kind of absence) in theory and practical in each subject for appearing of examination. There shall be no condonation for shortage of attendance. A candidate shall have 100% attendance in each of the practical areas before publication of result

VIII. RESERVATION:

The reservation of seats as per the norms of Government shall be made applicable in self-financing M.Sc nursing course. The committee of the self-financing MSc Nursing course will decide & distribute the number of seats among the candidates in each Speciality as per prescribed norm.

N: B: - The seats remains vacant against any reserve quota shall be filled up by the general candidates.

IX. BASIS OF SELECTION:

Selection of candidates into M. Sc nursing course shall be made on the basis of merit judged by the credit marks as mentioned at clause "X". Fifty percent of seats will be reserved for in-service candidates and fifty percent for direct candidates. Seats remains vacant in one category will be filled by other category.

X. AWARD OF CREDIT MARKS

1. 20% credit marks to be awarded on the percentage of marks secured (without extra Optional) in H.S.C. or its equivalent examination.
2. 20% credit marks to be awarded on the percentage of marks secured (without extra Optional) in Intermediate/+2 or its equivalent examination.
3. 60% credit marks to be awarded on the percentage of marks secured in the Basic B.Sc nursing examinations in case of the candidate passed Basic B.Sc nursing (4 years course) course.
4. 30% of credit marks to be awarded on the percentage of marks secured in the in General Nursing & Midwifery examinations and 30% of credit marks to be awarded on the percentage of marks secured in the Post Basic B.Sc nursing examinations or its equivalent examination in case of the candidate passed Post Basic B.Sc nursing course.
5. One mark per chance of failure in any examinations shall be deducted.
6. 5% credit marks shall be awarded on the total career marks to those who have completed at least 3 years of continuance service in KBK districts.
7. In case of tie, the date of birth will be taken into consideration and the senior one shall be preferred for selection.

XI. Admission of candidate

1. The candidates selected by the selection Board shall be required to produce all original Documents including Original College Leaving Certificate on the day of admission to the College.
2. If any candidate leaves after joining the course the fees paid shall not be refunded at any circumstances except Caution Money.
3. The selected Candidates shall have to furnish bond and agreement at the time of admission in the non-judicial stamp paper to serve the state Govt. for five years failing which their case may not be considered.
4. The selected candidates shall have to submit joining report at the College in the stipulated date to be intimated by the Principal and at no circumstances the joining date shall be extended and the seat shall be filled from waiting list without any intimation.

XII. Hostel Accommodation:

Hostel accommodation being limited, can not be guaranteed for all and allotment of seats in the Hostel will be made by the Principal to the needy and deserving candidates according to availability of seats.

XIII. Uniform:

Candidates should bring **sea blue colour** saree, blouse and white apron to wear while performing clinical and field practice and wearing of uniform is compulsory.

XIV. Fees

2. If any candidate discontinues in the midst of the academic session for any reason, she shall not be eligible to apply for P.G admission for subsequent three academic sessions.
3. A candidate has to submit medical fitness certificate in the prescribe form (Appendix-III)
4. In all matter relating to eligibility or otherwise of a candidate for Registration and admission in to M.Sc nursing course, the decision of the Selection committee shall be final.
5. Candidates noticed to have supplied wrong information, document, and testimonials at any stage shall be disqualified from the course and legal action as deemed proper shall be initiated against her.
6. Application without any enclosures /received by any other mode other than Regd. Post / Speed Post /Courier service or after due date shall be summarily rejected.
7. No request/undertaking for consideration for production of documents at later stage shall be accepted at any stage.
8. If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if his/her explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him/her from the institution.
9. The cut off date for registration, experience and qualification etc .shall be considered 30th June of the year of selection.
