Sir,


Kindly refer to this Department letter No-14029, dated-14.05.2018, No-14452, dated-19.05.2018, No-14628, dated-22.05.2018, No-14736, dated-23.05.2018, No-14725, dated-23.05.2018, No-15010, dated-26.05.2018 and No-15123, dated-28.05.2018 and No-15144, dated-28.05.2018 regarding relieve of in-service Medical Officers to pursue their higher studies in various discipline in different Govt. Colleges & Hospitals.

In this regard, I am directed to say that the concerned authorities have been requested vide the above references to relieve the in-service Medical Officers of OMHS Cadre working under their administrative control so as to enable them to pursue their higher studies in different Medical Colleges. For this purpose, it has been decided that the Medical Officers shall be relieved by their respective authorities with the following conditions:-

- a. The entire cost of the PG / SR/ MD/ MS course shall be borne by the doctor concerned in private Medical Colleges.
- b. The doctor concerned will pursue the PG / SR/ MD/ MS study by availing leave due and as admissible to him.
- c. The doctor concerned will give an undertaking to the effect that she will join in the State Government positively soon after completion of the PG / SR/ MD/ MS course, failing which the disciplinary proceedings shall be drawn against her.

It is, therefore, requested to follow the above conditions strictly before issue of the relieve orders in favour of the Medical Officers, who are seeking their relieve orders vide the above reference for the purpose of their higher studies in different Medical Colleges and report compliance to this Department immediately.


