Sub- Covid-19 training of all Health professionals and Supporting staff in all Govt./Private/Corporate and COVID facilities.

Madam/Sir

As you are aware that during first wave of pandemic all stakeholders involved COVID-19 management were extensively trained but because of resurgence and newer protocols/guidelines refresher training is highly required. Also, rapid increase in cases has necessitated augmentation of COVID Health Facilities and human resources to manage these facilities. Also, all health professionals in all Govt. and Private health facilities must be trained to screen/manage suspected cases. Similarly, all COVID warriors and community health professionals/volunteers also require training in different containment and IPC aspects. Therefore, following actions to be taken to ensure all are properly and adequately trained-

1. All Heads of MCHs/ hospitals/clinic (Govt.and Pvt.) to ensure that all health professionals and staff members are trained as per their job role and requirement.
