Sub: 20% additional manpower over and above IPHS norms on outsourcing basis for COVID treatment facilities.

Madam/Sir,

In continuation to the above cited letter, it is further clarified that as part of preparedness to tackle with the situation arising on account of the recent resurgence of COVID positive cases in the State, Government have now been pleased to allow 20% additional manpower over and above IPHS norms on outsourcing basis for COVID treatment facilities by District Authorities and Superintendent of Medical Colleges for a period of 3 months i.e. May-July, 2021 with the terms and conditions outlined in this Deptt. letter cited above.

Since the family members / relatives are not allowed to attend their patients in the Covid Hospitals / facilities, it is necessary to engage more no of manpower (specially ANMs & Staff Nurses/ Attendants) beyond IPHS norms as allowed vide this Deptt. letter under reference.

However, the number of such manpower to be engaged is to be judiciously & strictly calculated depending on the average bed occupancy rate. And such engagement

shall be purely temporary for a period of three months, May-July, 2021 and will be done through outsourcing.

Further, it is to reiterate that while engaging this 20% extra manpower there should be strict adherence to the conditions outlined in this Deptt. ltr. no. 12515 dt.26.04.2021 by the authorities .

This has been concurred in by the FD in FD file No.FIN-SOS3-ESTT-0034-2021.
