**Sub:- Functioning of District Level Committees for Audit of Quality of Care and Death Review**

**Ref:- This Office Order No. 23139/H dt. 10.10.2020**

Madam/Sir,

In inviting a reference to the subject cited above, I am to say that District Level Committees were constituted vide this Deptt. Order No. 23139/H. dated, 10.10.2020 (**copy enclosed**) for Audit of Quality of Care and Death Review. The roles of these committees was to audit the quality of care at Covid facilities as well as review the death of Covid positive / suspect patients in Government as well as in Private Hospitals in the district / Corporation area & also to examine the full medical records of the patients while auditing the quality of care and reviewing deaths with a view to further strengthen the system and improve Covid Response to save lives.

It is directed that the procedures mentioned in the order referred to above are to be meticulously followed. It is further instructed that the District Committees should be convened daily or every alternate day ( as the need may be) so that each case of death is reviewed within 48 hours of its occurrence.

Whereas the care of Covid positive patients is now extended across both the Government and Private sector in the State.

And whereas it remains the utmost priority of the State Government to prevent deaths of Covid patients by providing timely and quality care.

And whereas it is found necessary to have an oversight over quality of care and prevention of death of Covid patients.

Now therefore, the Government do constitute District Level Committees for Audit of Quality of Care and Death Review, to be headed by an officer authorised by the Collector / Municipal Commissioner and not below the rank of Additional District Magistrate. The CDM&PHO, an ICU trained doctor and Medical Officer of the treating facility will be amongst the members.

These committee will audit the quality of care at Covid facilities as well as review the death of Covid positive / suspect patients in Government as well as Private Hospitals in the district / Corporation area.


The Committee will examine the full medical records of the patients while auditing the quality of care and reviewing deaths with a view to further strengthen the system and improve Covid Response to save lives.






