**Bhubaneswar 14/09/2020,**

- Hon'ble Chief Minister Sri Naveen Patnaik today, sanctioned more than Rs. 50 Lakh from Chief Minister's Relief Fund (CMRF) to 84 applicants for treatment of critical ailments.
- In order to ensure better Covid management, Oxygen checking campaign is carried out in Ganjam District. As on date, more than 17 Lakh persons have been screened and necessary interventions are being provided to suspected cases based on Medical advice. Frontline Covid Warriors are actively involved in the campaign.
- As per direction of Hon'ble Chief Minister, persons who have successfully completed institutional quarantine are being given incentive of Rs.2000/- each. A sum of Rs. 133,56,61,000/- has been paid so far. This amount is given from Chief Minister's Relief Fund.
- From 13th September to 14th September morning, 01 case has been registered by the Police in the state for violation of different regulations and guidelines related to COVID-19.

### Health Update

- Up to midnight of 13<sup>th</sup> September, 24,72,517 samples have been tested.
- Number of Positive Cases stands 1,55,005.
- 1,18,642 persons have already recovered/ discharged.
- No. of Death case 637.
- No of active cases are 35,673.
- 35,673 persons are in Hospital isolation.
