

It is necessary to train the medical community; doctors, paramedics and others who will be involved in the direct management of the patients in the COVID hospitals and isolation wards of various health facilities. Considering the nature of the disease, extreme care and caution as well as professional approach need to be adopted. Therefore, it is decided that intensive training of the personnel in accordance with available protocols will be conducted.

Further, considering the dearth of doctors, it has been decided that the 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> Semester MBBS students of all medical colleges will be trained who could be deployed in case need arises. In the first phase, the training of govt. establishments would be taken up. The Private Medical Colleges will also be required to train the Doctors & students simultaneously.


