Sub: Restructuring & Corresponding Revision of Pay Structure of Odisha Pharmacist Service Cadre of Health & Family Welfare Department

In view of the increase in number of public health facilities, increasing patient load at Government Hospitals and increase in number of Drug Distribution Centres under Niramaya, Government after careful consideration have been pleased to restructure the Odisha Pharmacist Service Cadre in public interest for smooth and efficient functioning of health care facilities in following manner.

The detailed analysis of the Restructured Pharmacist Cadre :

1. Out of sanctioned strength of 3490 posts of Pharmacist in the scale of pay of Rs.25,500-81,100/- (Level-7 under ORSP Rules, 2017), 792 posts shall stand

abolished in lieu of creation of 1729 posts at different levels in the cadre hierarchy leaving 2698 posts at base level.

- The base level post of Pharmacist shall be re-designated as Pharmacy Officer.
2. The existing 508 posts of Senior Pharmacist at Pay Level -9 shall be re-designated as Senior Pharmacy Officer, Level-II. In addition to this, 927 posts of Senior Pharmacy Officer, Level-II at Level-9 shall be created arriving at 1435 posts which is the 1st level of promotional hierarchy.
 3. The existing 72 posts of Chief Pharmacist at Level-10 shall be re-designated as Sr. Pharmacy Officer Level-I. In addition to this, 695 posts of Senior Pharmacy Officer, Level-I at pay Level-10 shall be created arriving at 767 posts, which is the 2nd level of promotional hierarchy.
 4. There shall be creation of 107 posts of Chief Pharmacy Officer at pay Level-11, which is the 3rd level of promotional hierarchy.
 5. There shall be 2 posts of Assistant Director at Pay Level-12, which is the 4th level of promotional hierarchy.
 6. The total cadre strength will be 5009.

Necessary changes in Odisha Pharmacist Service (Methods of Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 2019 will be made by this Department in due course.

This Resolution shall come into force with effect from the date of publication of the Gazette Notification.

This has been concurred in by the Finance Department and GA & PG Department in their OSWAS File No.F IN-S0S3-ESTT-0020-2023 and GAD-SC-RULES-0027-2023 respectively.
